# **Summary of Position**

The **High School-Based Therapist** provides onsite individual and group therapy to students in the Oxnard Union High School District (OUHSD) with topics ranging from general concerns to dating violence and sexual assault.

#### **Fundamental Job Requirements**

- Provides individual and group therapy to identified students at multiple OUHSD sites.
- Provides some lunchtime presentations to staff and students on dating violence and sexual assault.
- Attends required individual and group supervision with assigned Clinical Supervisor.
- Collects clinical file documents as required by Navigation Team filing protocol; prepares client
  assessments, intakes, treatment plans, exit interviews, and other client documentation for
  confidential storage.
- Maintains weekly therapy records, including counselor notes on Coalition's Electronic Health Record system.
- Attends regular staff meetings as needed.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Director of Operations.

## Schedule

- This position is 15 hours weekly. The schedule will be determined at hire.
- Due to the essential functions of this job, arriving on time for your shift is an essential requirement.

## **Educational Requirements**

• The candidate must be enrolled in an accredited Master's-level counseling program (MFT, MSW) and have at least Trainee status.

## **Physical Requirements**

- Ability to speak English fluently is a requirement.
- Must be able to communicate with other professionals over the phone, through electronic correspondence, and in person.
- Fundamental job requirements occur inside multiple high school sites across Oxnard, CA.
- May be required to stand, sit, stoop, bend, and lift/move up to 15 lbs.
